- Must accurate, clear, easy to understand for the consumer, available and easily accessible
- Applies to any food intended for supply to the final consumer or to mass caterers
- Easily visible, clearly legible and, where appropriate, indelible
- Not hidden, obscured, detracted from or interrupted by any other written or pictorial matter or any other intervening material.
- For prepacked food, mandatory food information shall appear directly on the package or on a label attached thereto
- Language: easily understood by the consumers and according to national law

General Guidance:

- Must accurate, clear, easy to understand for the consumer, available and easily accessible
- Applies to any food intended for supply to the final consumer or to mass caterers easily visible, clearly legible and, where appropriate, indelible
- Not hidden, obscured, detracted from or interrupted by any other written or pictorial matter or any other intervening material.
- For prepacked food, mandatory food information shall appear directly on the package or on a label attached thereto
- Language: easily understood by the consumers and according to national law
- Same **labelling requirements** for online, distance-selling or buying in a shop

Label Content*	Explanatory note
Period After Opening (PAO) M or months	 Period of time after opening of the container for which the product can be used without any harm to the consumer Applicable to products with a minimum durability of > 30 months Indication: "PAO symbol" + number of months and/or years (how many months the product is still safe to use after it has been opened) Months can be indicated on or outside the symbol Not required for self-preserving products as high alcohol content perfume
Direction of use / Precaution	How to use the products and any special warning statement for professional use products
Product function	Unless obvious from, for example, the product name
Batch or Lot number	For tracking or traceability of the cosmetic product
Small packs	 precaution for use and other special warning, the ingredient list may be enclosed or attached in a separate leaflet, label, tape, tag or card Instruction, warning and ingredient notice maybe placed near where the product is placed sale
